This hospital is committed to compliance with the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention recommendations for hand hygiene practices.

Healthcare personnel are required to comply with the following protocol.



Use an alcohol-based hand rub or wash with soap and water



Use gloves and masks upon entering a patient's room

Healthcare personnel must wash hands for the following clinical indications:

- Before touching a patient
- Before performing an aseptic task
- After working on a soiled site, before working on a clean body site for the same patient
- After touching a patient or the patient's immediate environment
- After contact with blood, body fluids, or contaminated surfaces
- Immediately after removing gloves

This Healthcare facility:

- Requires healthcare personnel to perform hand hygiene in accordance with CDC recommendations
- Ensures that healthcare personnel perform hand hygiene with soap and water when hands are visibly soiled
- Ensures that supplies for hand hygiene are available and accessible in all patient care areas
